Motion:

The representative will be chosen by the SSSC board and will rotate each year. He/she will represent the SSSC with a specific list of agenda items and talking points to be prepared by the OI Committee. The SSSC representative will present a detailed written report of the visit to the SSSC Board within 30 days of the conclusion of the Festival including but not limited to meetings attended, relevant conversations engaged in, and general impressions of the event and participants.
