Whereas OGA was allocated a minimal travel budget with guidance to bring additional projects to the Board and Whereas OGA has submitted a list of projects totaling \$55,500 and Whereas the Finance Committee has reviewed the projects and is

recommending approval it is therefore

RESOLVED that the SSSC approves funding from its miscellaneous funds of up to \$55,500 for the events listed in the OGA 2025 Budget Addition and it is further

2. Whereas the SSSC understands the need to support the SDI Akal Dyal Yatra and is sending 3 Board representatives at a cost of approximately \$15,000 and

Whereas there is additional need to support the Yatra financially, it is therefore

RESOLVED that the SSSC will provide a grant to SDI of \$10,200 to be used as specified in the attached SDI Funding Request to the SSSC.

Whereas the LA Gurdwara could use additional support and

Whereas Gurutej Singh Khalsa has served this Dharma for decades and has the requisite skills to perform the functions listed above it is therefore

RESOLVED that the SSSC will furnish a one time grant from the KIIT Donor Advised Fund to SDI of \$40,000 for the period of September 1, 2025 to June 30, 2026 to fund a position for Gurutej Singh Khalsa and it is further

RESOLVED that based on SDI's assessment of the success of the position, SDI can request funding for 2026-2027 during the CCC grant process.
